GLOBAL WATER STRATEGY MEETING
January 27, 2010, 2PM

Please join other humanitarian agencies and organizations at the U.S. Capitol at 2PM on Wednesday, January 27, 2010, Capitol Visitor Center **South Meeting Room**, to discuss strategies to drastically accelerate the global effort to bring safe drinking water to the vast population in need.

One of those strategies, the 300in6 Initiative, emerged from the March 2009 World Water Forum in Istanbul and proposes to address 300 million individuals in need by 2015. The authors of 300in6 will be present to describe their effort, as will representatives of other international agencies at work on countrywide strategies.

A panel of NGOs and agencies at work on overseas drinking water and sanitation will review their own missions and views on how the pace of the international drinking water effort can be increased.

A desired outcome would be consensus by at least some of the organizations present that joint efforts can be undertaken that will speed the pace for reaching 2015 Millennium Development Goals.
